- (Day 1) Conduct State level verification of any 2 ODF declared panchayats so as to further ODF + activities like 'Solid Liquid Waste Management' and 'Piped water supply projects'. The team would verify the CLTS process adopted, toilet technology followed, payment process and more importantly, the access and usage of toilets.
- (Day 2) Provide resource support to carry out the district level orientation trainings (as per the calendar given below). The observations and feedback of the ODF verification would also be shared with the participants.
