Sub: Regarding district action on Geotagging drive from 3rd October 2018 to 15th October 2018.

Sir/Madam,

Based on the instruction given by the Chief Secretary, Government of Bihar on 18th November 2018 via Video Conferencing, a Geotagging Drive has been scheduled from 3rd October 2018 to 15th October 2018 as minimum 80% geotagging is compulsory for release of second instalment of SBM-G funds from MoDWS. To make this drive a success, certain build up activities have to be undertaken. These are explained as below:

1. Minimum one Geo-tagger per village in Blocks/districts has to be registered on the MIS website.
2. District water and Sanitation Committee can avail the services of **suitable and interested person** as per RDD letter no. 330162 dated 25/09/2017 in possession of a smartphone for geotagging of IHHLs (DWSC can advertise the same). Payment to these geo-taggers will be made in accordance with RDD letter no.330162 dated 25/09/2017.
3. Mapping(**M05**) and registration(**M01**) of the geo-taggers on MIS has to be done by 30th September 2018.
4. Allocation/Deallocation of IHHL to geo-tagger, now also available at block level, can be done using form **M02** and approval of geotagged photos by DWSC team at district Level using **M03**.
5. A one-day training has to be given to all new/untrained geo-taggers by DC/BC/DC-MLE&MIS/ZSBP and subsequent trainings, if needed has to be ensured.
6. Every geo-tagger has to geotag a minimum of 50 IHHL per day during this drive.
7. A printout containing a list of all the allocated IHHLs to a geo-tagger must be handed over to him/her for his/her convenience.
8. For timely approval of geotagged IHHLs, a team of minimum 4-members that may consist of District Coordinator, ZSBP, DC-CB&IEC, DC-MLE&MIS, district IT manager,

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Executive assistant etc. has to be formed. Specific block-wise responsibility of approving geotagged photographs would be assigned by DDC-cum-Vice Chairman, DWSC to the team members.

9. It will be **mandatory** for Block and District officials to make random verification visits to the geotagged households to ensure quality of geotagged photographs.
10. Daily follow up at block/District/State level regarding no. of geo-taggers registered, No. of photos uploaded, no. of photos unapproved and approved in given format would be carried out.

Upon analysis it has been found that total 30.53 lakhs IHHL are yet to be geotagged and total no of registered geo taggers are only 18166. As explained in point no 1 above, there is a gap of around 20972 geo taggers (Total no of villages -38803) (Attached in Annexure I) which needs to be filled. In addition to this, if all these geo-taggers, geotag 50 IHHLs per day, the entire drive can be completed within 7-10 days.

It is therefore requested to kindly look into this personally so that the target set by the Chief Secretary is met within the stipulated timeline.
