

- Length: 2 pages maximum
- Spacing: Double-spaced. Font: 12 point
 All proposals for nomination must include the following sub-sections, separated by easily recognizable section headers:
- Introduction
- Specific project aims to which the contribution relate to
 - Significance of the contribution made by the proposed awardee.
 - Approach /Methods. Used by the proposed awardee, please indicate why this approach or method should receive award.
 - Outcomes of the contribution made by the proposed awardee.
 - Short Bio with a picture as an attachment.

1. Review process

All applications/nominations will be reviewed by an inter-disciplinary review committee set up under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, SBM-G, MDWS. Gol. The applications will be judged on the following criteria:

- Significance of the contribution.
- Impact of the contribution made.
- Appropriateness and value of contributions.
- Adequacy and appropriateness of approach and methods applied.

Subject: <u>Invitation of nominations for 'Swachh Awards', 2017</u>

As you may be aware, the Hon'ble Prime Minister during his 'Mann ki Bact' address on 27th August 2017, called upon the nation to undertake a campaign, 'Swachhta Hi Seva' (SHS), Cleanliness is Service, at least fifteen-twenty days prior to Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October – on the lines of the age-old belief, Jal Seva Yahi Prabhu Seva, Service to Water is Service to God. The aim of the campaign is to intensify the focus on cleanliness and create an environment of cleanliness across the country in the spirit of a Jan Andolan.

- 2. The Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation is organising the 'Swachhata Hi Seva' campaign throughout the country from 15th September 2017 to 2nd October 2017, to generate mass public action on sanitation and cleanliness. The Ministry has planned a series of activities involving all stakeholders to inspire every Indian to perform *Shramdaan* to clean up public places, construct twin-pit toilets in the rural & urban areas of the country and contribute towards creating a mass movement for Swachhta. The media is being mobilised to generate awareness and contribute to making this an unprecedented national movement on sanitation. Many activities are being planned from 15th September to 2nd October, 2017 which are expected to be done at all levels about which details are being shared separately.
- 3. On the culmination of SHS, on the occasion of the 3rd anniversary of the Swachh Bharat Mission on 2nd October 2017 (Gandhi Jayanti), a national event will be organized (Swachh Bharat Diwas), where the Hon'ble Prime Minister is likely to present the awards for exemplary contribution to Swachh Bharat. Apart from other Awards, the 'Swachh Awards' in SBM-G will be in the following categories:
 - i. Exemplary leadership in making villages ODF (GP/Sarpanches/ Sachiv/ Traditional leaders/ Village headmen/ Tribal Leaders)
 - ii. Swachhagrahis that have done exemplary community mobilisation work
- iii. Rankings on Swachhta Darpan (as on 20th September 2017): State, District. The participation of States and Districts in the Swachhta hi Sewa and Swachh Sankalp Se Swachh Siddhiwill also be accounted in deciding the ranks in this category.

- 4. The Ministry is pleased to announce a Request for Applications/Nominations by State and District Governments for grant of the award. All applications/nominations will be reviewed by an interdisciplinary review committee set up by MDWS, Gol.
- 5. The nominations should reach the Ministry by 20th September, 2017. Nominations received after 28th September will not be considered by MDWS. The nominations in the given format may be emailed/sent to the States in the format given at Annexure I. The States may forward the same to the Ministry by the due date. You are requested to also transmit this call for Nominations to Districts for nomination at District level.
